Measures for working in and around a house

Follow these rules to work safely during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Talk about them with the residents or owner of the property you will be working on.

Follow the basic rules:



If you have symptoms, stay home and get tested



Stay 1.5 metres away from other people



Wash your hands often



Cough and sneeze into your elbow

The following specific rules apply to your work:



Travel to work with your own transport.

If this is not possible, do a health check before travelling in a shared vehicle. Keep as much distance as possible from other passengers. Wear a face mask if there are 3 or more people in the vehicle. Keep the vehicle clean and ventilated.



Ask if everyone is healthy.

Every morning ask your client whether anyone in the household has cold symptoms, a fever and/or shortness of breath. If you have doubts, leave.



When to wear a face mask.

In a public indoor space, and in spaces where you cannot keep 1.5 metres from others, in addition to the other basic rules. Ask your client and colleagues to give you plenty of room to avoid the need for a face mask.



Healthy workspace.

Ask your client to ensure the place where you'll be working is easy to access, clean and well ventilated.
